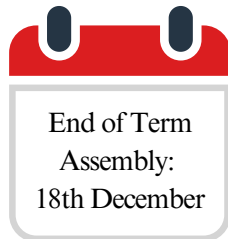

Lastly, a massive congratulations to Akin Okl in Year 4 on being commended for his writing piece for the National Lambing Flat Writing Competition!



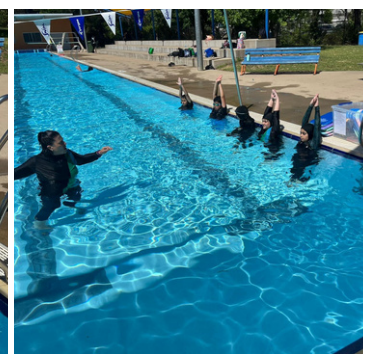
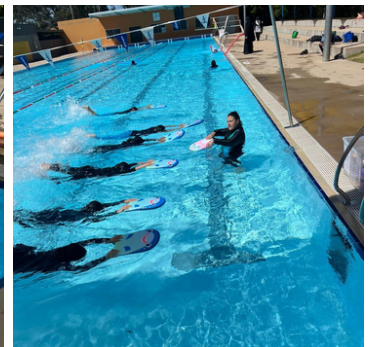
The organisers warmly applauded Akin's outstanding work, praising the impressive quality of his writing and the maturity he showed for someone of his age.
