

Staff Dress Guidelines

<p>HEAD COVERING Sunnah cap recommended.</p> <p>CLOTHING Professional and neat attire on formal events, conferences, and parent teacher interviews. (Sunnah clothes need to be professional in appearance). Smart casual or professional attire on school days. Shorts must be below knees (3/4 length) including non-student days or sporting events. No singlets, all shirts must be T-length or long sleeve. Non see through fabric. Loose fitting- not showing contours of the body.</p> <p>SHOES Closed shoes required for OH&S reasons. Maintain professional look.</p> <p>PERSONAL/ GROOMING Nails are to be kept short. Hair to be kept neat and professional. No earrings or jewellery should be worn.</p>	<p>HEAD COVERING Fully Covered- No hair exposed. Non see through fabric. Professional and neat. Neck/chest/ears must be covered. Islamic etiquette is to ensure that chest area is modestly covered with the draping of the scarf. Tied up hair should not be high near the top of the head but should be behind.</p> <p>CLOTHING Loose fitting abayah/dress or skirt with top. If skirts are worn top should be long to mid-thigh length - not defining contours of the body. Trousers or tights should be worn underneath clothes. Should conceal the whole body with the exception of face and hands.</p> <p>SHOES Closed shoes required for OH&S reasons. Maintain professional look.</p> <p>PERSONAL/ GROOMING Keep nails short. No nail polish.</p>
