AN INSIGHT INTO OUR GEMS WEEK OF LEARNING

Assalamu alaikum!

Asalam Alikum friends and family. A few parents have been asking how their child is going and I am happy to report I am very happy with their overall progress within the first 4 weeks. Currently we are working on our numbers from 1-5 and if they are able from 5-10. A few students are still flipping their numbers around and while all seem capable of recognising them and putting them in order a few are still struggling to write them. We do ask though that you make an effort to read to your child each night as this imparts many import skills to them such as understanding that words (that are made up of sounds) make stories, that text flows from left to right, up and down and that words are broken up by sentences.

Homework will officially start to go home in week seven once Kindergarten has a greater understanding of what they are doing. We will also be sending home some alphabet cards to assist students in retaining their sounds.

I hope to see you all in your Sunnah clothing next Thursday (pictures will be posted up in Seesaw and on the New Medinah website)
