Keep an eye out as in the next fortnight we have a couple of small community excursions coming up in science including going down to the shallow part of the lake to collect living samples (land and water) and a larger K-2 excursion to Chainman's Dam to conduct a living things assignment.

In English we are currently learning about recounts. The children understand that they must think about events that have happened to write about them in order. It can be helpful at home to reflect after a trip or event by getting your child to tell you about what they have done using the words 'first', 'then', and 'lastly'.

In Art the children have been engaging with a range of materials to make pictures using shapes. Ms Warda posted some photos on Seesaw so please login to have a look. and in PE we've been improving jumping skills.

In Science we've been learning about living things. The children really enjoyed exploring animal footprints that were stuck to the floor around the classroom. It was great to see them talking together about how to work out which Australian animal made each set of prints.
