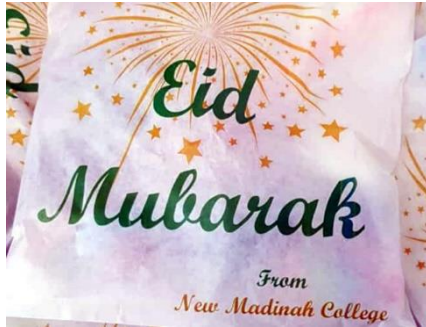

I encourage you to promote reading within your home or even find a spare ten minutes to sit with your child and support their reading. I have had some comments from students suggesting that they don't understand parts of the text; this will be a perfect opportunity to bond with your child whilst assisting their education. Students have also composed narratives of their own which they are excited to enter into the Write 4 Fun competition. Some went above and beyond, creating short stories that were multiple pages long!

In other subjects, Stage 3 continue to be engaged and seem to be enjoying their learning. In Art, students regularly learn new skills surrounding our topic Natural Still Life. No doubt you have seen the photos on the SeeSaw mobile app, and if you haven't, I encourage you to do so. It is easy to download from the App Store or Google Play and gives you a first-hand look into your child's learning.

Stage 4 have continued with their units as well. In English, they have analysed comics from multiple angles. They should have a clear understanding of how stories are presented to the reader and why they occur in such a way. Moving forward, they will begin to look at elements of horror within texts, which should be interesting. In Geography, they have learned the skills of area and grid referencing. For any of you out there who still have a street directory in your car, ask your Stage 4 children to locate places on a map and they should do so with ease!

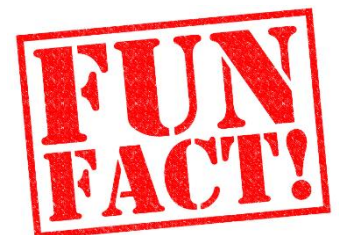
OPEN DOOR POLICY
