Welcome to the last term of the year. At the moment, in English we are focusing on persuasive texts and paragraph structure using PEEL. In Maths we are focusing on Number and Algebra and the students are building on skills they learnt earlier in the year.

This term our special topics are electricity for Science, liveability for Geography, performance for CAPA and in PE the focus will be on swimming. In Science the students will be learning about electrical circuits and how we get and use power. They'll be doing some experiments throughout the term and learning how to record their observations. Their assessment for this subject will be an in class exam later in the term. In Geography they'll be using maps and research skills to learn about places in the world and what makes a place suitable for living. They will have a take home assessment task for this subject which they will receive next week inshaAllah. The students are very excited about writing and performing a play about bullying for CAPA. InshaAllah you'll see this at the end of year assembly.

Swimming will be on Friday so students will need to come in PE kit with their swimsuit under (don't forget underwear and a towel). They may bring croc style shoes (not thongs) but also need to have their school shoes.

NO PLAY


The No Hat No Play policy is in full swing this term and will continue throughout term 1 of 2019. Please ensure students come to school with their school hat clearly labelled with their name.
