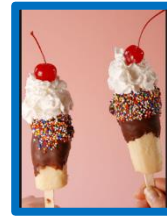




## 3/4 EMERALD

I pray you all have a good weekend and have benefitted from the glorious rain that has been falling. May Allah SWT continue to bless us. – Ms Ellen



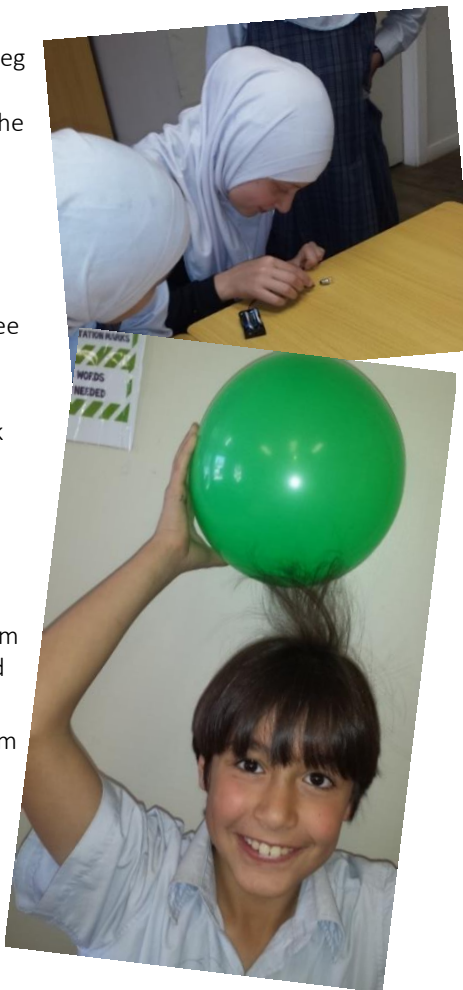
## 7 DIAMOND
